1. \$70 Entry Fee due by February 25th. After this date, late registration is \$80. Payment can be made online at www.loganvilleptso.weebly.com or **Venmo @lhs-ptso**
2. Sponsorship contributions due by March 4th to be included in the program.
3. Must attend all practices/rehearsals.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Contestants must be female, never been married, or had a child.
2. Judges' decisions are final! Talking with the Judges while they are judging is prohibited. If any family, friends of the contestants, or the contestants themselves violates this, the contestant will be disqualified. Score sheets will not be given out.
3. Good sportsmanship is required at all times. **Failure to show good sportsmanship** (including parents and guests) **will result in disqualification of the contestant without refund.** This includes after the pageant including text, Facebook, or any social media, etc.) Please notify an adult in charge if any bullying happens during the pageant.
4. **All registration funds are non-refundable.** However, should the pageant be cancelled due to COVID-19, all payments will be refunded.
5. Miss LHS Pageants reserves the right to refuse admittance to anyone that the director, PTSO Board, or school Administration feel may be a security risk. This includes all pageant events.
6. Miss LHS Pageants and the host buildings are not responsible for loss due to injury incurred at, or in travel to and from all pageant events. We are also not responsible for any thefts that may occur.
7. Miss LHS Pageants, PTSO Board, and school Administration require high moral standards, therefore, any contestant or winner caught engaged in such acts as bullying, drinking/drugs, smoking, swearing, posting anything inappropriate on social media, etc. will be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the director and the PTSO Board. Furthermore, contestant must have never been expelled from a Walton County Public School or have an arrest record of any kind.
8. Raising financial support beyond the registration/entry fee is optional, but appreciated. Pageant proceeds support the PTSO Scholarship Fund for LHS graduating seniors.
9. Photogenic competitions are optional.
10. This also serves as a consent release for any media publications in which the contestant's picture may be published.
11. All queens will be required to participate/lead at least 3 community service projects.
